	A solo-authored writing sample of at least 5,000 words must be submitted as a separate pdf file. A paper from a graduate class is sufficient.
	Print this document, complete all parts of it, scan it into your computer, and submit it as a separate pdf file.
	Applicants who wish to optimize their chances of admission and funding should complete all steps of the application process by February 1.
	Late applications are accepted until July 1, but will only be considered when room is available. It is possible but highly unlikely that funding will be available for applicants who file their application materials after February 1.
