Letter of Interest/Personal Statement

Students seeking admission into the Child Welfare Training Program are asked to write a letter to the Program Coordinator requesting program admission and a senior field placement with Child Protective Services. The letter should be reflective and carefully thought out. It should be typed and double-spaced. Please incorporate the following as well as any additional information pertinent to field education.

- 1. The development of your interest in child welfare social work.
- 2. Why are you applying for a practicum at Child Protective Services? Why are you a good candidate for the IV-E program?
- 3. What concerns, if any, do you have about entering the program and potentially working at Child Protective Services in the future?
- 4. Your personal strengths as well as your personal limitations.
- 5. Your life experiences, which have influenced your development and may affect your helping skills.
- 6. Areas of personal and professional development that you would like to focus on during your field placement.
- 7. Any pertinent personal information (family of origin, your present family, educational experiences, or achievements, UNT experiences, campus, social or civic associations).

In regards to questions 4 and 5 & 7, you are asked to provide any personal information that will contribute to an overall picture of who you are. This it is important to include any relevant experiences that might impact your field placement, the clients served, the field instructors, agency staff, or the learning process in general. The following are examples of information that may be relevant to share: conviction of a felony, substance abuse problems and/or psychiatric treatment, chronic illness, victim of a crime, performance problems in prior work situations.

All information that you provide is handled in a confidential manner and may be provided to TDFPS Hiring Specialist as a part of the Title IV-E application process.

	dergraduate practicum student requires adherence to certain professional standards. I agree that, ile participating in the field instruction component of the UNT BSW program, I will:
1.	Adhere to the Codes of Ethics of both the Texas State Board of Social Work Examiners and the National Association of Social Workers.
2.	Follow all laws of the State of Texas and all other jurisdictions in which I might practice.
3.	Comply with all agency policies and procedures. I agree to review all agency policies and procedures within two weeks of beginning the practicum. I further agree to adhere to the UNT Student Code of Conduct.
4.	Come fully prepared and participate actively in all scheduled meetings with the Agency and University Instructors. I agree to meet at least weekly with the field instructor for supervision and notify the practicum instructor if I miss any supervision sessions. I understand that it is my responsibility to arrange supervision meetings with the field instructor.
5.	Come fully prepared and participate actively in all academy and practicum seminar classes. I understand that missing two or more classes in a semester may result in my failing the class.
6.	Provide proof of insurance if using my vehicle for agency business.
7.	Conduct myself in a professional manner at all times. This includes being punctual, reliable, and responsible in all field practicum assignments, as well as interacting in a professional manner with all clients and co-workers.
8.	Negotiate a learning contract with my field instructor and submit it in writing to the practicum instructor by the second seminar meeting, if applicable.
9.	Attend all meetings and turn in all assignments related to the practicum and the seminar class as specified in the syllabus.
